- Through <u>Variety's Special Needs Program</u> funding is available, up to \$5,000, to assist families in covering the cost of any of the following for their child:

**MEDICAL EQUIPMENT AND SUPPLIES** such as: **hearing aids and batteries**, artificial eyes, diabetic supplies, **eyeglasses**, feeding supplies for newborns, **medical equipment for home support**...

**SPECIALIZED PROGRAMMING AND THERAPY** such as: **speech and language therapy**, occupational therapy, physiotherapy, **music therapy**, hippotherapy...

ASSISTIVE TECHNOLOGY such as: ipads, computers, tablets, LeapPads, educational apps...

**MOBILITY EQUIPMENT** such as: **power and manual wheelchairs**, powered scooters, hippocamp beach and all terrain wheelchairs, **adaptive tricycles and bikes**, hand bikes, standing walkers, special needs strollers, custom orthotics, Chill-out chairs, freedom climber, crawler, stair glides/elevators and mechanical lifts and slings, **wheelchair ramps** and home modifications...
